

Poplar Tree HOA Internet Acceptable Use Policy

Purpose Statement

The Poplar Tree Homeowners Association maintains a website and provides access to the Internet as a means to better communicate with our residents, and to provide an additional service at our pool and Community Meeting Center. All Internet resources accessible through the PTHOA are provided equally to all users, with the understanding that it is the individual user's responsibility to demonstrate judgment, respect for others, and appropriate conduct while using PTHOA resources.

Internet access will not be used for illegal activity, to access illegal materials, or to access materials which by local community standards would be obscene.

PTHOA Developed Webpages

The PTHOA has developed a variety of webpages with recommended links in order to facilitate use of the Internet. Users should recognize, however, that the Association is not responsible for changes to the content of linked sites, nor for the content of sources accessed through subsequent links.

Rules of Conduct

1. Internet access will not be used for illegal activity, to access illegal materials, or to access materials which by local community standards would be obscene.
2. Users will respect copyright laws and licensing agreements.
3. Users will not make any attempt to gain unauthorized access to restricted files or networks, or to damage or modify computer equipment or software.
4. Users will respect the privacy of other users, and will refrain from attempting to view or read material being used by others.
5. Internet access will not be used to harass or intimidate others.
6. Internet access will not be used for hacking, spamming, or any other unlawful activities.
7. PTHOA does not monitor, and has no control over the information accessed over the Internet, and is not responsible for its content.
